## ZTE AIMS TO DOUBLE SALES

Chinese IT firm ZTE Soft expects to double its India revenues to \$160 million by March 2014 and hire 300 more people locally within next one year. "We expect to

post 100 per cent growth in our revenue at \$160 million by March 2014 from India business. We posted \$80 million revenue from India in December 2012," ZTE Soft's Senior vice president Nie said. ZTE Soft, which is subsidiary of telecom equipment firm ZTE, currently manages software services for BSNL in three zones, nine circles' operations of Sistema Shyam and two circles of Idea Cellular. It has about 100 people working with it directly. — PTI
